Prince2 Project Management Foundation

Course Overview

PRINCE2 is universally accepted as a best practice project management method. It is designed to provide a structured approach to managing projects with a view to increasing the likelihood of a successful project outcome. The method can be used for projects of any size or complexity, and provides guidance through clearly defined principles, themes and processes.

Why PRINCE2?

Many corporate clients in the UK and across the globe require that PRINCE2 methods are used in the management of their projects, as it provides a common language and a proven structure for aiding successful project delivery. From an individual perspective, many employers search out candidates that have obtained the PRINCE2 qualification, as it demonstrates that you have a good understanding of how to successfully manage projects using a globally accepted best practice method.

Prerequisites

There are no essential prerequisites for this course. However, candidates would benefit from a general awareness and knowledge of project management, and experience of managing a project or participating in a project as a team member.

Course objectives & expected benefits

Candidates will gain a thorough understanding of the PRINCE2 method, and will be shown how to use (and tailor) this method in a real project environment. This course will help candidates prepare for the Foundation exam. In order to progress, candidates will need to sit the Practitioner exam – which is not part of this course.
